To Eagle Crest Institute - Thank you for being my launching pad. I'll always be grateful for your guidance, encouragement and belief in me when I needed the most.


And to every young dreamers out there - This is a path that demands resilience, hardwork and heart. But if you have the passion and preserverance, it will reward you in ways you can imagine.




#### JOURNEYS THAT INSPIRE.
